Porsche

The Porsche Carrera GT is also a mid – engined sport car. The car was made by Porsche in 2004-2007, and only 1,270 were produced. In fact, 1,500 cars were planned, but unfortunately only 1,270 were produced. It costs \$440,000, and the car goes up to 205 miles per hour.



Bugatti

The Bugatti Veyron was first introduced in 2005. Its also a mid-engined grand touring car, manufactured by French mark Bugatti. The super short version of the Veyron is the fastest street-legal production car in the world, with going up to speed to 268 miles per hour. But it's very expensive; it costs \$1,500,000.



Audi

A fourth generation coupe sport car is the Audi S5! The Audi is a high performance convertible car! It goes up to speeds of 155 miles per hour. It is a 4-wheel-drive car and expensive. It costs \$120,000,000!
